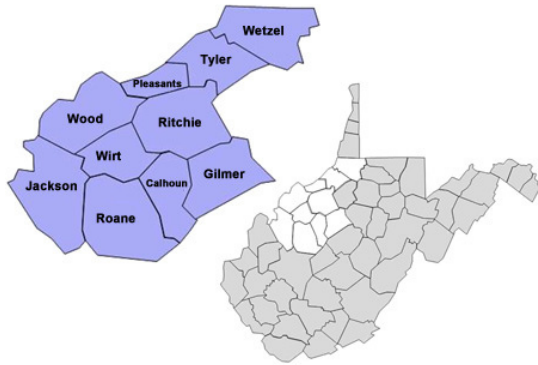

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OUR HISTORY

The Mid-Ohio Valley Rural Health Alliance (the Alliance) represents a unique coalition of health care organizations and entities spanning ten counties. These organizations have joined together because of a desire to share resources and coordinate the use of limited resources, more efficiently and effectively. The Alliance works on projects to assure continuity of care, community health, education and shared services.

The shared vision is to improve the health status of the communities served by the Alliance. This is defined as the ten county area population (estimated at 180,000) served by the Mid-Ohio Valley Rural Health Alliance.

The Alliance members will collaborate to develop patient centered initiatives focusing on community health improvement, disease prevention, improving access to health care and developing an electronic information system to create a seamless system of care.
